



It is time for a new approach to peacemaking. Peace processes that are built from the ground up, not top down. Peace processes that make people believe peace is achievable. It is time to make peace









effective, inclusive and lasting peace efforts. It embodies eight interlocking and mutually

einforcing principles. Dignity, solidarity and

humility, will inform all actions, decisions and interactions. Strengthened by accountable security, Legitimacy, is the lodestar. These are put into practice by promoting pluralism,

adopting subsidiarity, and embracing

integrated and hybrid solutions.


with a strong alliance of partners, practical guidance and mechanisms will be cocreated and contextualised to bridge the gap between policy and practice, towards more sustainable peace.




Ensuring fair and equal participation in public life and providing equitable access to institutions & services across communal, political, social, economic & gender divides.
